The Mission:

The Role:

The Children's Ministry Director reports to the pastor and is part of the church's Ministry Team.

The Vision:

- **Safe** - the physical and spiritual well-being of our young people is non-negotiable. Background checks, prudential policies, and thorough training will be part of making sure that our ministry is done safely.
- **Intergenerational** - as often as possible and in as many ways as we can, we will minister to the children of our church and community in such a way as to weave them into the generational fabric of the church.

- **Sustainable** - our approach to children's ministry needs to employ the sort of simple and organic techniques that can survive disruption and be useful to busy families.
- **Confident** - our approach to children's ministry starts with the assumption that the Holy Spirit is at work in the lives of children before they come to us and after we are done ministering to them and that children are naturally disposed to spiritual growth.
